That is notable, but not necessarily in conflict with the spec. Should these types of differing or additional functionality be noted somewhere?
- 5. Pairtree / Appletree
 - a. Which way do we want to configure it?
 - b. What about implement pairtrees as in Modeshape, but in the API the pairtrees are not resolvable instead return a 404. Possibly allow you to PUT an intermediary resource later.
 - c. Some performance testing would be helpful.
