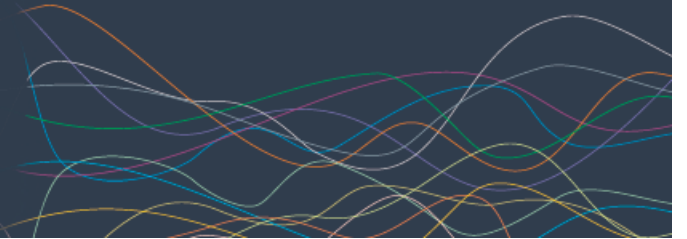

- 2003-2008 Cornell creates VIVO for life sciences, expands to all disciplines
- 2009-2012 NIH awards \$12M to become an open source platform
- 2013-2015 VIVO joins DuraSpace, adds member support
- 2019 LYRISIS acquires VIVO, widens community


