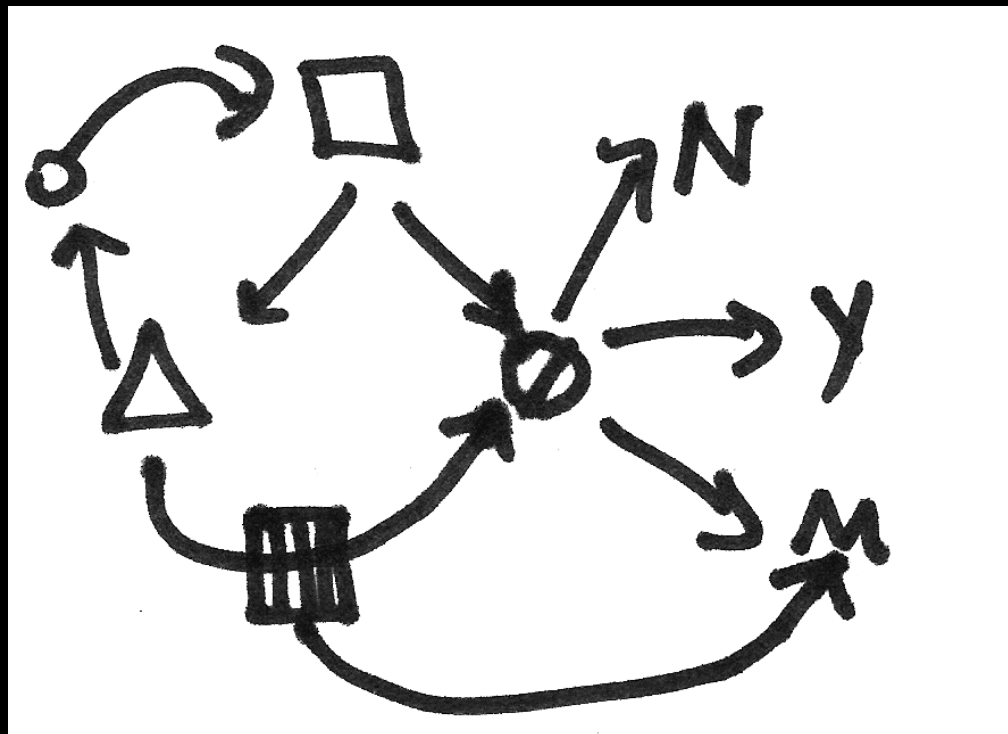

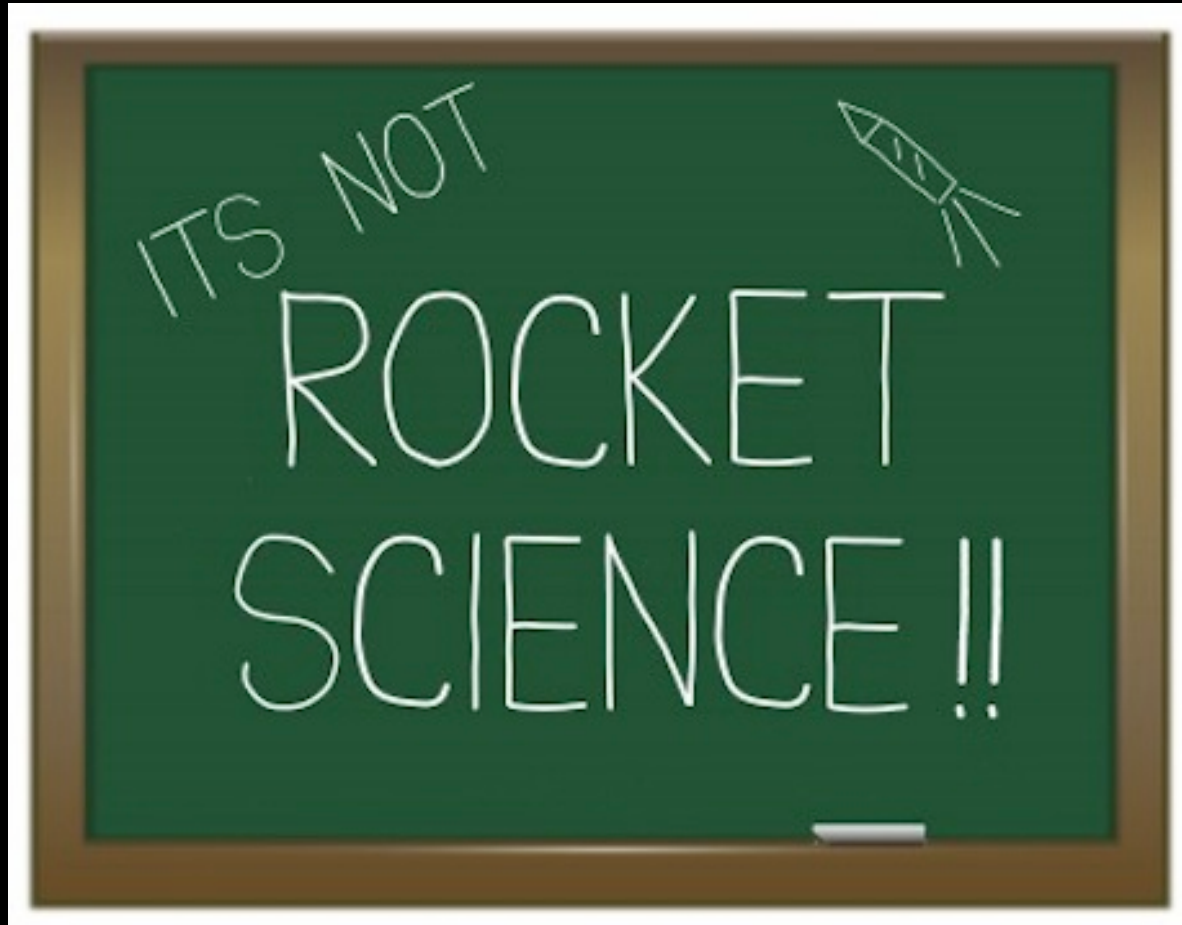

- Provides strategic guidance and support to the Project Director.

Leadership Group

The Steering Group will bring issues to the Leadership Group for decisions in the following categories:

- Annual budget allocations
- Substantial changes in allocations during the year
- Strategic product roadmap
- Strategic direction.
