5.1 ISNI public database

ISNI endusers can propose corrections to data or suggest improvements via the public database or the webcat form.¹

All records on the public database contain a contribution form for enduser comments/queries. This is accessed using the “Please help us improve this record” box which can be viewed on the left hand side of each record.

5.2 ISNI user input alert emails

All completed contribution forms are automatically collated at the end of each day. They are then submitted via email to the ISNIQT inbox (British Library) and ISNIBNF (BNF).

The subject heading of the email is "ISNI user input alert", along with the date the queries were collated, e.g.

ISNI User input alert on 2014-01-29

Note that an email is sent daily to ISNIQT and ISNIBNF, even if there are no enduser queries. This email will be blank and can be deleted.

It is possible to search manually for user queries that are waiting review by ISNIQT and do not contain a \$g subfield². This would normally be done when there is a fault with the user input alerts. However, it is recommended that a manual search is carried out occasionally to ensure that all queries waiting review are dealt with promptly.

To manually retrieve queries awaiting review, enter the following command into the search bar:

fin unt: [year-month-day]*

For example, to retrieve queries from 30 July 2014, enter the following command:

fin unt: 2014-07-30*

Queries can also be retrieved by month or year, e.g.:

fin unt: 2014-07* – *retrieves user queries awaiting review for July 2014*

fin unt: 2014* - *retrieves user queries awaiting review for 2014*

5.2.1 Email format

ISNI user input alert emails contain the following data:

- Pica Production Number (PPN) of the record on WinIBW which the enduser has viewed on the public database
- The date/time the query was submitted
- The first main heading listed in the record, along with the data source
- The enduser comment/query

This example contains the standard format for ISNI user input alert emails. The following data is included:

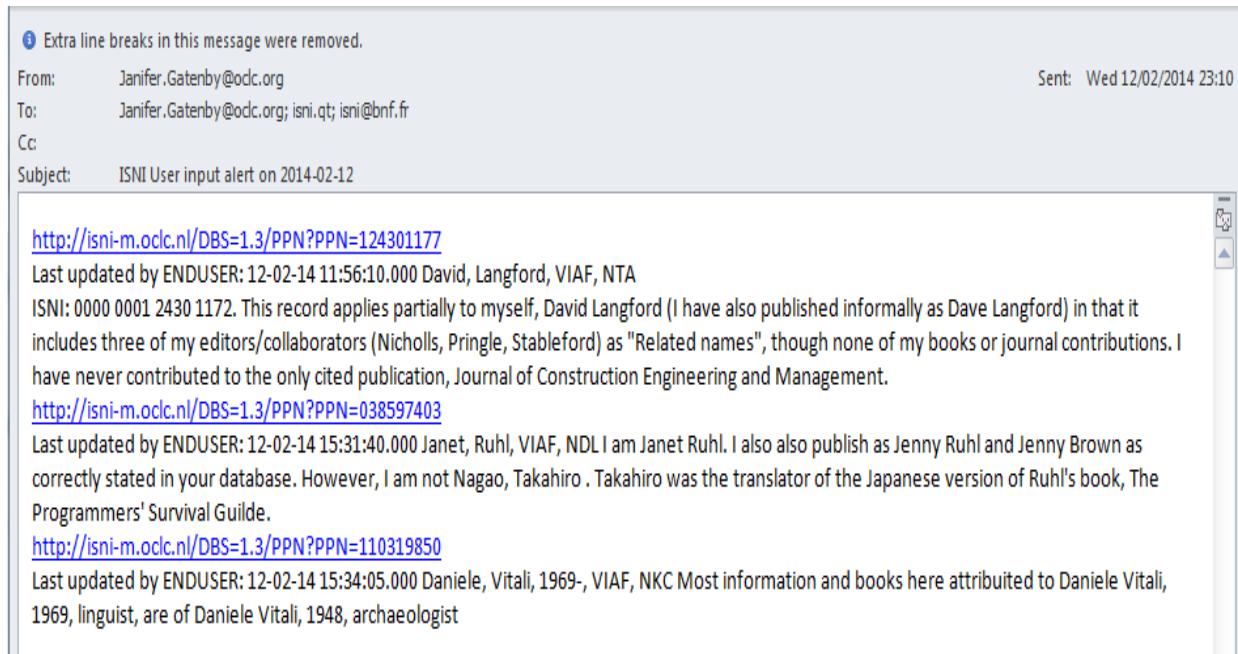
- <http://isni-m.oclc.nl/DBS=1.3/PPN?PPN=067237606> – 067237606 is the PPN of the record on WINIBW which the enduser has viewed on the public database.³
- **Last updated by ENDUSER: 10-02-14 19:20:14.000** – the date/time the enduser query was submitted, e.g. 10th February 2014 at 19.20.
- **Victoria, Strauss, VIAF, LC** – a main heading in the record (700 field, MARC21/028C PICA) is Strauss, Victoria. The data source for this heading is VIAF LC (Library of Congress/NACO)
- **Full list of titles: Arm of the Stone, The Awakened City, The Bleu Passion Burning Land, The Color Song Garden of the Stone, The Guardian of the Hills Horčí Zeme: Cesta Áratova - kniha první Lady of Rhuddesmere, The Passion Blue Verdensstenen Worldstone** – this is the comment/query from the enduser. The enduser (in this case the author) is requesting that specific titles be added to their ISNI record.

As the user input alert emails are collated at the end of each day, they may contain multiple queries by separate endusers.

The following user input alert email from 12 February 2014 contained 3 queries by 3 separate users:



The next step is to carry out any editing work that may be required on the records identified in the user input alert email. Editing will need to take place in WinIBW.

5.3 Types of enduser queries

Some of the more common types of enduser queries include:

5.3.1 Disambiguation

The identifier 0000 0003 6604 1713 includes some of my work and some other other people's. I'm the writer of Child of Fire Game of Cages Circle of Enemies Twenty Palaces King Khan, a Spirit of the Century novel enfants du feu, Les Feuerdämon and more to come. I have nothing to do with the Harry Connolly who wrote Fighting Chance or Heading Home.

Here, the enduser (in this case the author) is highlighting that their record contains titles by other identities.

5.3.2 Additional information required

Last updated by ENDUSER: 11-02-14 15:12:18.000 Theresa, Crater, 1950-, VIAF, LC Thanks. Also Theresa L. Crater

In this example the enduser is requesting that an additional form of name be added to their ISNI record – Crater, Theresa L.

Here, the enduser (in this case the author) is requesting that the title "Alaskan summer" be added to their ISNI record.

5.3.3 Duplicate entries

0000 0001 2125 3953 and 0000 0003 7244 528X are the same composer Alessandro Scarlatti, with the same dates of birth and death and the same type of roles

In this example, the enduser is highlighting that there are 2 records on ISNI for the same identity.

Last updated by ENDUSER: 17-09-13 16:32:40.000 I believe this is the same organization as ISNI: 0000 0001 1498 781X

Here, there were duplicate entries for the same organization.

5.3.4 Data errors

Last updated by ENDUSER: 22-10-13 23:06:14.000 Glenn, Greenwald, VIAF, NTA Glenn Greenwald is not deceased.

In this example the date of birth had been wrongly coded as a date of death.

5.3.5 Identifiers (e.g. ORCID, Researcher ID, Scopus)

Endusers may request that identifiers other than ISNI are added to their record.

Other identifiers include⁴:

ORCID (Open Researcher and Contributor ID) - a subset of ISNI uniquely identifying scientific and other academic authors with a 16-digit identifier (<http://orcid.org/>)

ResearcherID - assigns unique identifiers to researchers (www.researcherid.com)

Scopus - a bibliographic database containing abstracts and citations for academic journal articles (<http://www.elsevier.com/online-tools/scopus>)

Examples

The ORCID identifier is currently separate from ISNI. Endusers may request that their ORCID identifier is added to their ISNI record, e.g.:

5.3.6 Data suppression

Last updated by ENDUSER: 20-03-14 23:06:14.000 Please remove my birthdate from the ISNI database.

In this example, the main heading from VIAF SUDOC contained the enduser's date of birth and the full date of birth was contained in the 970 field (MARC 21). The enduser is requesting that all references to their date of birth are removed from the ISNI database.

5.3.7 Deletion requests

Endusers can request the cancellation/deletion of their ISNI:

Last updated by ENDUSER: 20-03-14 23:06:14.000 I have no books forthcoming, under contract, or published. Please remove me from your database. There should be no record for me at all

5.3.8 Bowker entries

Manual entry via Bowker

In this example Bowker (<http://www.bowker.co.uk/en-UK/>) have manually created a record on the ISNI database. The contributor code for this type of record is SCHU – ProQuest Scholar Universe. There is normally no query in regard to the data and no reply to Bowker is required.

However, Bowker may have highlighted web links which can be added as public notes by ISNIQT. For details about adding web links, see 5.4.3.3.

The addition of titles with the source "ISNI" is also usually required. For guidance on adding titles, see 5.4.3.1.

5.4. Editing

5.4.1 Searching by PPN

To edit the record login to WinIBW⁵. Call up the record using the PPN in the ISNI user input alert.

The PPN is 067237606. This can be viewed in WinIBW by inserting the following command in the search bar:

FIN PPN: 067237606⁶

The record will then display on screen.

5.4.2 General non-public note

The record in WINIBW also contains the query from the enduser, as found in the user input alert email. This can be found in the general non-public note (MARC21 field 667/PICA: 0470). This note includes the following data:

- The enduser query, as found in the user input alert email - *\$a subfield*
- A contact email address for the enduser (this is optional so may not always be present in the record) - *\$e subfield*
- The date/time the enduser query was submitted - *\$f subfield*
- The source of the query (normally ENDUSER, but could potentially be another ISNI data contributor, e.g. VIAF, RING, BOWKER, etc.) - *\$2 subfield*

This example contains the standard format for general non-public notes generated from enduser queries. The note includes the following data:

- *\$a* subfield: **Full list of titles: Arm of the Stone, The Awakened City, The Bleu Passion Burning Land, The Color Song Garden of the Stone, The Guardian of the Hills Hořící Země: Cesta Áratova - kniha první Lady of Rhuddesmere, The Passion Blue Verdensstenen Worldstone** – enduser query
- *\$e* subfield: **victoria@victoriastrauss.com** – enduser contact email
- *\$f* subfield: **2014-02-10 19:20:14** – date/time of query
- *\$2* subfield: **ENDUSER** – source of query

Once the enduser query has been viewed, the next step is to consider any editing that may be required on the record and potential enhancements to the existing data.

5.4.3 Editing data and enhancing the record

If editing work is required on the record, please see the guidelines in Chapter 4.

Examples of the types of editing that may be required are:

- **Correcting data errors and notifying sources (4.2)**
- **Disambiguating records (4.3)**
- **Merging records (4.6)**
- **Splitting/deprecating records (4.7)**
- **Adding links in the 95X field (???)**

For guidelines on editing organisations, see chapter 7.

5.4.3.1 Adding data

When adding data to a record such as a title, ISBN or a variant name, the source of the data will be "ISNI".

Example

In the following query the enduser has requested that the title "Alaskan summer" be added to their ISNI record.

The title is added to the record with the source "ISNI", along with details of the publishers (921 MARC21/033A PICA) and dates of publication (943 MARC21/032B PICA) provided by the enduser.⁷

The error message states that the source code "ISNI" is contained in the 910, 921 and 943 MARC21 fields but is not found in any main heading.

When saving the record a contributor code is automatically added for ISNI. This can be found in the 035 field (MARC21) or 003Z field (PICA)⁹.

We would normally add data when requested. ISBN's are frequently provided by endusers and are useful for matching purposes¹⁰.

However, there may be cases where judgement will need to be applied. ISNI does not strive to collect and display a full bibliography for individuals.

Where an enduser has supplied extensive bibliographical data (e.g. a full list of titles and ISBNs) it may be more efficient to add web links to enable access to the information, as opposed to manually listing each title, ISBN, publisher, etc.

For information about adding web links, see 5.4.3.3.

For examples of replies to endusers who have submitted extensive bibliographies, see 5.6.1.8

Note that the titles of some ISNI data contributors are not displayed on the public database. Rights management societies and trade sources restrict their titles, dates and related names from the public.

BOWKER (which includes the sources BOWKER, BOWKA, BOWP, SCHU, PROQ, AMS, AGLD, MLA) do not allow their titles to be seen by other ISNI members or the public.

If titles are not displaying and are not listed by other data sources in the record then it is useful to add them with the source "ISNI".



5.4.3.8 Deletion requests

Endusers can request the cancellation/deletion of their ISNI. We would delete the data in accordance with the ISNI data policy:

“Upon request from the data subject, ISNI will delete the personal data, without undue delay, and notify each data subject of its deletion, unless this proves impossible or involves a disproportionate effort.”¹⁹

To delete records on the ISNI database, see 4.5 in the ISNI guide.

5.5 Reviewing the record

5.5.1 Adding the \$g subfield

Once any work has been completed, a “reviewed” status will need to be added to the record on WinIBW.

This “reviewed” status is achieved by adding a \$g subfield to all note fields in the record (667, 668, 670, 671 - MARC 21). A lower case “r” is added to the \$g subfield, signifying that the record has been reviewed and the work is complete.

The \$g subfield is manually inserted before the \$u subfield, where present. If there is no \$u subfield the \$g is added before the \$2 subfield.

Once the subfield has been added, save the record in the usual way by selecting the "enter" key.

5.5.2 Viewing the record in the ISNI public database

It is best practice to view the record on the ISNI public database, once the work on WinIBW is complete.

This is the view that the majority of endusers have of ISNI, so it's important to ensure that any changes to the record on WinIBW are clear on the public database²⁰.

Once the record has been viewed in the public database and the work is complete, a reply will normally be sent to the enduser.

5.6. Replies to endusers

Where a contact email address has been added by the enduser, they should receive a reply. The email address can be found in the \$e subfield of the general non-public note (see 5.4.2).

Where an email address is not present in the record then no further contact is required.

- The name and address of the person in the ISNI Quality Team who has carried out the work
- A copy of the original query
- The subject line of the reply would normally be "ISNI user query" and the date the query was submitted in ISO format, e.g. ISNI user query, 2013-07-17

5.6.2 Storing email replies to endusers²¹

All email replies to endusers should be copied to the ISNIQT folder.

Emails would normally be added to the "Replies to users – completed" folder unless a response was required from the enduser, e.g. a request for further information. In these cases the email would be added to the "Replies to users – pending" folder.

Completed queries are recorded on a spreadsheet entitled "ISNIQT enduser query log". This can be found in the ISNI folder on the shared drive.

The purpose of the log is to record the number of queries received, the timescale of completed queries and a summary of the nature of each query in order to indicate patterns, e.g. added titles; link to website added; record needed disambiguation.
