Issues discovered in testing

1	Unable to locate Jira server for this macro. It may be due to Application Link configuration. Orphaned chunks are not removed in duracloud. There is a bug in the sync tool. When in non-jumpstart mode, the file is retransferred and the chunks are removed. So the scenario we are talking about is as follows: - user uploads 20 GB file with 1 GB chunks producing 20 chunks. - user uploads the same file using a pre-6.1.0 version of the synctool but changes the chunk size to 5 GBs. - Now there are still 20 chunks, 0000-0003 are 5GBs, 0004-0019 are 1GB. The 1GB chunks are the orphans. - Using the new (6.1.0) version of the synctool, the orphans won't be removed in non-jumpstart mode because the synctool will detect that the unchunked checksum will match the manifest. In that case, the synctool moves on. When jumpstart is enabled, cleanup will be invoked, but at the cost of retransferring the content. We have a tool for identifying orphaned chunks and removing them which we have used successfully in the recent past. We could force the synctool to perform a cleanup when it detects matching files. Or we could support that feature when a flag is enabled. Or it would also be possible to prevent the cleanup, when a flag is present. As far as duracloud operations are concerned, making cleanup on matching files the default behavior and providing a flag to suppress it for power users is optimal since we won't have to worry about scrubbing spaces after users upgrade to 6.1.0. For the users, the best option is for us not to implement "cleanup on checksum match" in the synctool.	Thanks for calling this out Danny. I know that the scenario you're calling out has occurred, but it is definitely an edge case. Considering that we have other tooling to discover and clean up this issue directly I don't think it's necessary to burden the SyncTool process with checking for orphaned files on each file it touches. That has the potential to significantly slow down the sync process, especially if many small files are being transferred. I'll make the call to leave the SyncTool as-is for 6.1. We will definitely want to encourage all users to upgrade to the new SyncTool as soon as it is available.

3	When deleting more than 2 spaces as a root user, the "are you sure" dialog appears (and require a confirmation click) 1 time less than the number of spaces being deleted. So if attempting to delete 5 spaces, you need to click "ok" 4 times. Resolved in PR: https://github.com/duracloud/duracloud/pull/106			I'm seeing this behavior now, too. Looking into it.
