- -How does CAT role relate to DGOC simply representatives/liasons from DGOC and Cmtr group? Discrete group? Must come from DGOC?
 - -role rotation all of us being involved all the time might be too much need a defined timeframe for just a few individuals
 - -the rest of DGOC would support w/some feedback/brainstorming/muscle, possibly tap into Ambassadors for more networking/feedback
 - -CAT role needs to appear open to anyone in the community
 - -have the DGOC/CAT members take responsibility for testing, formalize and take turns
 - -still involved with w/DGOC regular mtgs/mtg spaces
