Guidelines:

Members of the DuraSpace user communities frequently present at various conferences and user group meetings. Some of the presentations are useful resources and can easily be included in the KnowledgeBase. Below are some general guidelines:

- Select presentation slides which describe a topic reasonably, especially since the KnowledgeBase audience was not present to hear the
 presenter.
- · Select presentations topics that will stand the test of time and will not be out-of-date with the next software release.
- If possible, provide both a native presentation file (.PPT, .ODP, etc.) in case other members of the community would like to re-use the slides as well as a PDF version.
- To embed a link to slides that are already posted in a repository or some other website, use the following syntax in the "Wiki Markup" edit mode:
