

How do I reinstall Fedora using the same configuration as a previous installation?

When you install Fedora, the options you select in the installation process are recorded in a properties file: `install.properties` in `$FEDORA_HOME/install`.

When you are doing a new installation of Fedora, you can use the `install.properties` from a previous installation to create a Fedora installation with the same configuration.

Simply specify the `install.properties` file as an argument when running the installer, eg:

```
java -jar fcrepo-installer-x.y.jar install.properties
```

If you have made additional configuration changes, for example to your `fedora.fcfg`, you will also need to re-apply those changes.
