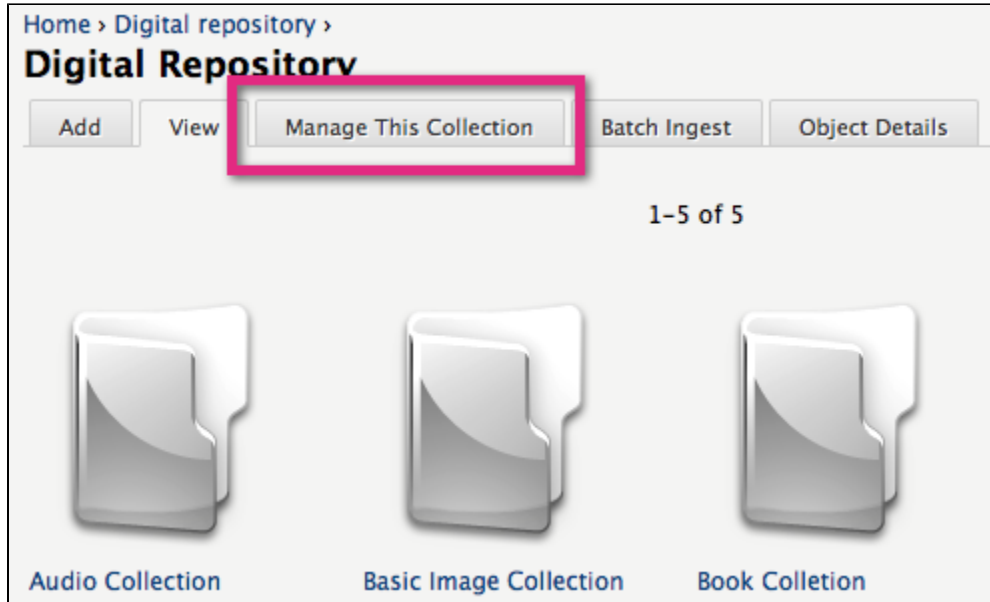


How to Manage Collection Policies

You can use the Collection Manager to add a content model to a collection policy, or to delete a content model from a collection policy. This allows you to control which content models are visible to users when they import objects into a collection.

1. Navigate to a collection and open the Collection Manager.

Choose a collection and click the 'Manage This Collection' tab at the top.



2. Add a content model to the collection policy.

Expand the 'Manage Collection Policies' section and then the 'Add Content Model' sub-section. Choose a content model to add and assign it a
