

# 2011-12-29 Implementation Call

## Updates

- Cornell
  - planning VIVO 1.4 update next week
  - planning data cleanup, e.g. orphaned triples
- Weill Cornell
  - completed testing VIVO 1.4 on a local machine
  - starting testing VIVO 1.4 on test server
  - meeting with Cornell dev team to go over future VIVO use cases
  - finalize publications ingest (Scopus and PubMed)
  - using an SAP MDM module to track data business processes
- University of North Texas
  - training new team members with VIVO virtual appliances, deploy.properties and permissions
  - Jon recommended starting with VIVO 1.4, since it supplies more info
- WashU
  - running VIVO 1.4 on local machine, skipping 1.3
  - upgrading QA server to VIVO 1.4
  - having some challenges with Harvester (mapping to internal data is smooth), e.g. performance/resource issues – who else is using it successfully? WCMC using it for publications, grants and demographic ingests (leveraging Google Refine to clean dirty data)

## Special Topics

- Making it easier to get data into VIVO, using the Harvester or other – possible track for 2012 Implementation Workshop?
  - recipes for getting Scopus publications data into VIVO, e.g. using PubMed central IDs (link to grants?) qualified by faculty? Maybe not as much of an issue for medical schools.
  - clearinghouse for Harvester scripts and recipes?
  - understanding how to best request non-copyrightable bibliographic data as an extension to library subscriptions
  - improving matching algorithms and determining what has changed during periodic updates
  - evaluate semantic web tools that tracks adds/deletes of triples like a Master Data Manager, Cornell wants to look at TopBraid Composer ([http://www.topquadrant.com/products/TB\\_Composer.html](http://www.topquadrant.com/products/TB_Composer.html))
- Working with CU-Boulder on an Implementation Fest ([2011 Implementation Fest materials](#))
  - timing?
  - tracks? intro vs advanced tracks – versus Jon's suggesting starting with 1st day intro and 2nd/3rd days more advanced
  - staggering policy vs implementation tracks?
  - topics?
  - adding to documentation
  - video recording or livecasting workshop? Maybe simple screencasting?
  - allowing invited institutions to vote on program?
  - workshop application/invitation process – challenges, lessons learned
  - best way to canvas VIVO community for instructors and their availability, then narrow down date range and canvas community of attendees – Kristi and Alex will follow up offline
