Story	<p>Researcher C joins the project and improves the interim data. The improved data needs to be stored in Fedora as a new version of the previously stored record. So, the items deposited in Fedora are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The new version of the data• An RDF-based record about Researcher C• An RDF-based metadata record describing the new version of the data and the research methodology. This also includes relationships between the new version of the data, metadata, Researcher C along with Researchers A and B, as well as the source data and the project record (items 1 and 4 in use case 2) <p>So, the URL of the new version becomes: http://www.domain.com/resource/metadata/1/version2136 which has links to the previous version, Researchers A, B and C, the project record, and the new version of the data.</p> <p>Note: Improve SOAP/REST API to handle deposit, edit and query final research data outputs.</p>
