

End User - Flexible licensing

Title (Goal)	DSpace should allow the user to select a range of licensing terms when depositing and display those terms to an end user who wants to download the item
Primary Actor	End User

Story (A paragraph or two describing what happens)	Sally wants to deposit a technical report under a CC-BY license. She could also put a CC-0 license on the report if she desired. When she goes to look at the item after it is deposited, it is very clear on the item page that the item has a CC-BY license because it uses the standard CC logo and description blocked URL
