

Installation

In this section, you will find installation instructions for Islandora, aimed at different use cases:

Virtual Machine

Suitable for new users who want explore or experiment with Islandora, requiring minimal time and set-up. Aimed at a general audience.

Enterprise

Suitable for full installations of Islandora in a development or production environment. Aimed at users with some technical experience.

Migration/Upgrade

For existing Islandora installations, covering the migration or upgrade of each major component of an Islandora site: Drupal, Islandora Modules, and Fedora.
