

Upgrade Ubuntu 12.04 LTS and prior to 14.04 LTS, and well as Java JDK 7 and prior to Java 8

Ubuntu 14.04 LTS and Java JDK 8 are requirements for Fedora 3.8.1, so you might as well do the upgrades and test the whole software stack while still on Fedora 3.7.0.

```
# $FEDORA_HOME/tomcat/bin/shutdown.sh
# /etc/init.d/apache2 stop
```

- After the upgrade you probably need to uninstall apache and install it again, to ensure all new components go in the correct place.
- Follow this link to upgrade [Java JDK 7 and prior to Java 8 \(from Oracle\)](#) or [OpenJDK 8](#).

```
# $FEDORA_HOME/tomcat/bin/startup.sh
# /etc/init.d/apache2 start
```

Proceed to test your upgrade by accessing your Drupal/Islandora webpage, and go through the testing procedure of each milestone.
