- https://github.com/OIT-ADS-Web/vivo_widgets
- widgets powered by a separate Solr core. Data synced nightly.
- allows embedding of VIVO content into other sites
- working on addressing common request - create a CV
- build four citation types for each publication on ingest - allows faculty to choose citation style for output
- Using React.js
- CV output is a single page JavaScript application
