1. Hash URIs

- a. Comments seem to indicate a little bit of a consensus on proposed behaviour
- b. No expressed opinions/preferences/concerns/comments regarding implementation approach
 - i. No clear understanding right now of tradeoffs of approaches, or cost of implementing
- c. Is anybody committed to actually implementing the fix?
 - i. Not sure if [Esmé Cowles](#) is planning on implementing, or is just facilitating the discussion and doing some exploration
 - ii. [Aaron Birkland](#) indicated a future business need for this functionality, though a ways off into 2016. Will likely need to produce a fix if one isn't already in place by then. No resources right now, though
- d. Is this a critical bug? What are the consequences of limping along?
 - i. Consequence is left-over resources that cannot be removed
 - ii. It is unclear if anybody is actually using it right now in a manner that presents a problem to them
- e. Hydra's PCDM ordering seems to be the biggest concrete use case right now
 - i. Still, it seems a rather odd use case to drive Fedora's functionality and APIs
