 - Two outstanding issues
 - Unable to locate Jira server for this macro. It may be due to Application Link configuration. - the upgrade of the a
 - Causes problems or drop-in replacement, which is a problem for a point release.
 - Changes syntax from RDF 1.0 -> RDF 1.1.
 - [Esmé Cowles](#) supports the proposed fix, and will review and test.
 - [Kevin Ford](#) will test as well.
 - N.B. this will be removed in 4.8.0 release.
 - [Kevin Ford](#) proposed creating a wiki page with basic info on releases that are planned.
