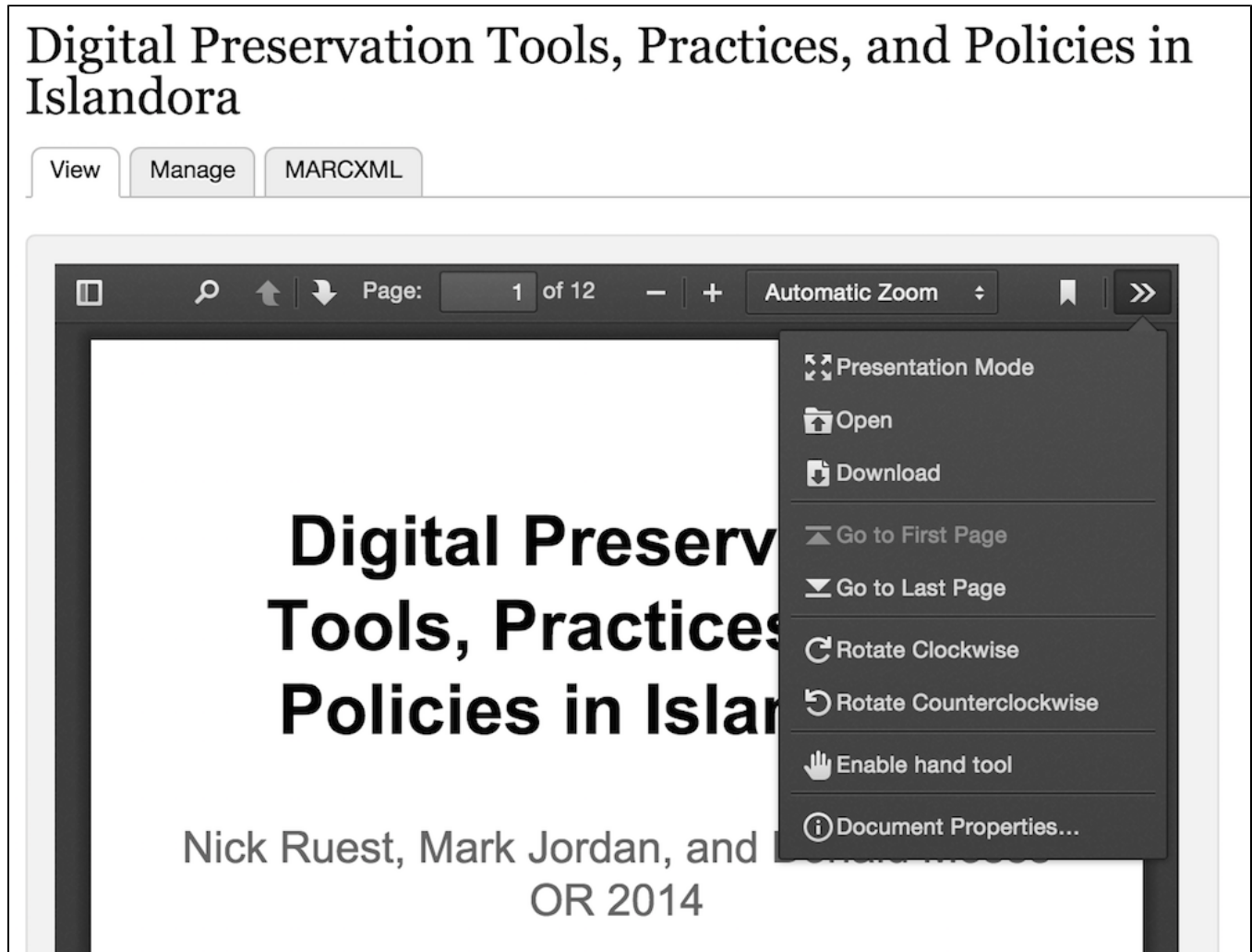
Installation

Install the **Islandora PDF.js** module as usual, see [this](#) for further information.

You also need to [Download](#) and [install the generic build of PDF.js](#) and move the directory to the sites/all/libraries/pdfjs directory, or run `drush pdfjs-plugin`.

If you use the Drush command, ensure that your `.drush` directory contains the install script `islandora_pdfjs.drush.inc`. If it doesn't, move (not copy) that script from the `islandora_pdfjs` module's root directory to your `.drush` folder before you run the drush command.

This is what the PDF frame looks like with the Islandora PDF.js viewer enabled.

The pdf.js Reader will work as the default viewer for newspapers only if each issue object has a PDF datastream. Otherwise, you may get an error message.

Troubleshooting/Issues

- Ensure that the PDF.js library is installed in /sites/all/libraries/pdfjs and the Drupal Libraries module is installed and enabled
- If enabled as the default viewer for the Book Solution Pack, you need to ensure that there is a PDF datastream in the Book object.
 - You can upload your own PDF file or have Islandora create it for you at the time of ingest or post ingest.

You must have both ImageMagick and GhostScript installed to create/combine PDF files. This will also update the PDF datastreams for each Page object.

DPI - Dots Per Inch

Set the DPI for the generated PDF. The higher the resolution the longer the process will take.

Create PDF

- Using the pdf.js Reader for Book and Newspaper/Issue objects.
 - If you depend on Islandora to create the PDF files for you it is important to understand that Islandora does not embed text (OCR) inside those PDF files, which means that your users will not be able to use the Acrobat toolbar's Search function to find and highlight hits within these files. If you want to Acrobat's searching function to work, you will need to externally perform text recognition on the PDF files and upload them to Islandora.
- The PDF.js site provides a [list of supported browsers](#) that implementers may want to consult should there be rendering issues.
