

- 1. New JIRA workflow -- includes "Received" and "In Review." No longer includes "Resolved."
  - a. Tickets do not automatically open. They are marked "Received" to start.
  - b. Once there's a pull request, the ticket is marked "In Review."
  - Tickets previously marked as "Resolved" have been moved to "Closed"
  - d. You may enter a ticket, assign it to yourself, and mark it as Open, and then "In Progress" when work begins.
- 2. Tickets "In review"
  - a. Suggestion: Two reviewers, one of which is a committer, neither of which is the author review and approve. With two reviews, the pull request can be committed.
  - b. Options for committer.
    - i. Click "Merge"

- ii. Click "Squash" and "Merge" to get the commits into one commit and then merge. This might be the default.
- iii. Surgically combine some commits into groups, merge groups



- 3. Sprint topics (...or what comes out or the march is strategy meeting)
  - a. Initial announcement (Planning and Sign-up page)
  - b. Dates for sprints:
